Private Archie Foden, the son of Mr. Robert Foden, of Littledale Road, a Wallasey Guardian is reported officially as missing. In a letter home Private Alec Urinowski, who was wounded, stated that Archie Foden assisted him to a place of safety, so that the official announcement is somewhat difficult to understand.

Seacombe Guardian's Loss  
(July 1916)

Mr. R. Foden, one of the Seacombe representatives on the Birkenhead Board of Guardians, have received an intimation from the War Office that they are constrained to conclude that his son. Private Archie M. Foden, 1/4<sup>th</sup> Cheshires,

is dead, seeing that he has been missing since August 15<sup>th</sup> of last year.
