Mrs. Sarah Forshaw, of 3, Richmond Street, New Brighton, has lost her youngest son, Private Arthur Frederick Forshaw, of the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment, who was killed in action on July 15<sup>th</sup>.

New Brighton Marksman Killed

Another New Brighton man to forfeit his life during the recent severe operations was Private Arthur Frederick Forshaw (30), of the Loyal North Lancashire's, who was killed in action on July 15th. Private Forshaw, who

enlisted when war commenced, soon proved his adaptability for a soldiering life, and as a marksman with a rifle he annexed several prizes. During the last winter campaign he suffered from frostbite, and was accordingly invalided to England. The youngest son of Mrs Sarah Forshaw, 3, Richmond Street, New Brighton, deceased was very popular in the neighbourhood where he resided. Two other brothers are also with the colours, one of whom has recently been released to work on munitions.
