<p>Chronicle News</p> <p><u>Patriotic Liscard Brothers</u></p> <p><u>Two Missing, One Wounded</u></p> <p>Mr. William George, 8, Coningsby Drive, Liscard, has received official notification from the War Office that two of his sons are reported missing since July 7th, and a third is in a French hospital. They are Pte. Frank Edward George, who formerly played under Walter Clutton for Wallasey and later acted as professional to the Hightown club, and Joseph Ernest George who was in the employ of the Vacuum Oil Co. before enlistment. The eldest son, Pte. William Henry George, is stated to be suffering from shell shock. All three are attached to the Cheshire Regiment, whilst a fourth son, Harold, is in the Navy.</p>
