Only Son Killed

The sad news has been received that Pte. Tom G. Green, King's Shropshire Light Infantry, was killed in action on Sept. 24th. Only 19 years of age he joined the Army on May 14, 1917, being drafted from Ireland to France on the 21st of March last. He was educated at St. Francis Xavier's College, Liverpool, and was apprenticed with Messrs. Woodson's Ltd, King Street, Egremont. An accomplished pianist he studied with Mr Wilfred Shaw. He was the only surviving child of Mr and Mrs Edward Green, 9, Sydney Avenue, New Brighton.
