#### News Report

##### Seacombe Soldier Dies From Wounds

News has been received by telegram and letter from the War Office that Pte. Jack. M. Greenlees, of the Gordon Highlanders Gate (K.L.R.) died from wounds received in action on May 8. He joined the Liverpool Scottish, January 1915, and had been twelve months in France. HE was educated at St. Michael's School, Liverpool, and was employed with Messrs. Dargue, Griffiths and Co., engineering specialists, Liverpool. An enthusiastic sportsman, particularly cricket, he was formerly a member of Liscard Cricket Club. He was 26 years of age, and the youngest son of Mrs. Ellen Greenlees, and of the late Mrs. M.S. Greenlees. 7, Hothfield Road, Seacombe.
