<p>Chronicle News</p> <p><u>Wallasey Corporal's Fate</u></p> <p>The sad news has been received by Mrs. Jones, 20, Greencroft Road, Wallasey, that her brother, Lance-Corporal Harry Griffiths, of the 1/5<sup>th</sup> King's Liverpool Regiment, has been killed in action in France. A son of the late Mr. W. Griffiths, Isfryn, Llangian, North Wales, the deceased was only 22 years of age. He joined the colours shortly after the outbreak of war, and had been in France seventeen months.</p>
