Egremont Butcher Killed

The sad intimation has just been received that Pte. Frederick Swift (Fred) Guest, K.L.R., died from wounds as he was being carried to the Casualty Clearing Station, on Sept. 18. He was only 18½ years of age, joined up last May, and was drafted to France in June. He was educated at Manor Road Council School, and was a member of the Y.M.C.A. He assisted his mother in carrying on her business of a butcher at 6, Stringhey Road. He was the seventh son of Mrs. Mary Guest, and of the late Mr. Thomas Guest, 18, Marsden Road, Egremont. Three other sons are serving with the Forces in France.
