News Report

Seacombe Sapper Killed

Mr and Mrs George Hariott, of 25, Byron Road, Seacombe, have received official news that their youngest son, Sapper Joseph Henry Harriott, Royal Engineers, was killed in action on the 23rd August. He was in the Territorials at the commencement of the war and mobilised in August, 1914. He was moved about from place to place looking after the search-lights, and it was not until last Easter that he was drafted to France. He was 22 years of age, and was educated at Somerville Council School, and previous to enlistment was in the employ of Messrs. J. Bibby and Sons, Liverpool. He attended Oakdale Presbyterian Mission, and was a good all-round sportsman, football and swimming being his favourite pastimes.
