#### News Report

##### Former Poulton Cadet Killed

News was received from the War Office on Tuesday morning by Mr. and Mrs. Highton, 12 Pelham Road, Liscard, of the death of their youngest son, Private Walter Highton (aged 20 years), who was killed in action in France during an engagements about November 13<sup>th</sup>. He joined the Kings Liverpool Regiment in October 1915, and was drafted to France last June. Previous to enlisting he was a member of the 1<sup>st</sup> Poulton Cadet Corps, T.F. His happy disposition made him a favourite with all, and he will be sadly missed by his relatives and friends.
