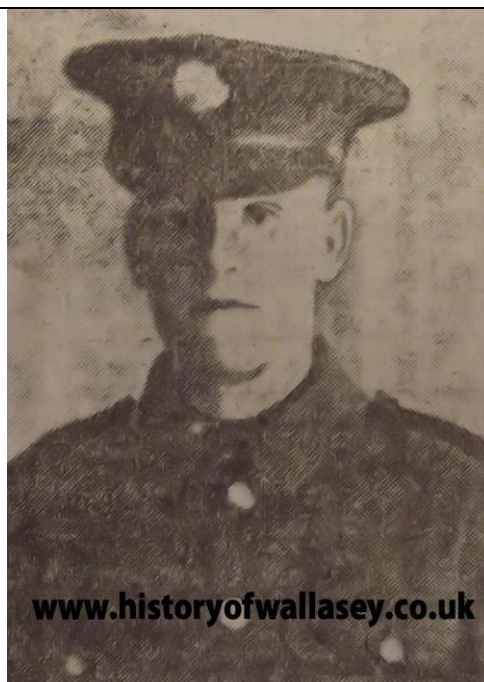

News Report

An Only Son Killed

It is officially reported that Pte. William H. Hill, of the Cheshire Regt., whose parents reside at 11, Ashville Road, Seacombe, was killed in action in France on July 31st. Pte. Hill, who was the only son of Mr. William Hill, signalman at the Seacombe Station of the Wirral Railway, joined the colours at the age of 16 at the outbreak of war, and had seen considerable service in Palestine from where he was eventually transferred to France in June. He was formerly employed by Mr. R. Holmes, butcher, of Wallasey.
