<p>News Report</p> <p><u>Seacombe Grocer Killed</u></p> <p>Official intimation has been received that Private F.W. Hodges, King's Shropshire Light Infantry, was killed in action in France on Dec. 1. The deceased young soldier was 24 years of age and was the youngest son of Mrs. J. Hodges, 24, Lathom Avenue, Liscard. Before joining he was employed at Messrs. Pullens, grocers and provision dealers, St. Paul's Road, Seacombe. He left for France in Oct., and had only been at the front six weeks when he was killed.</p>
