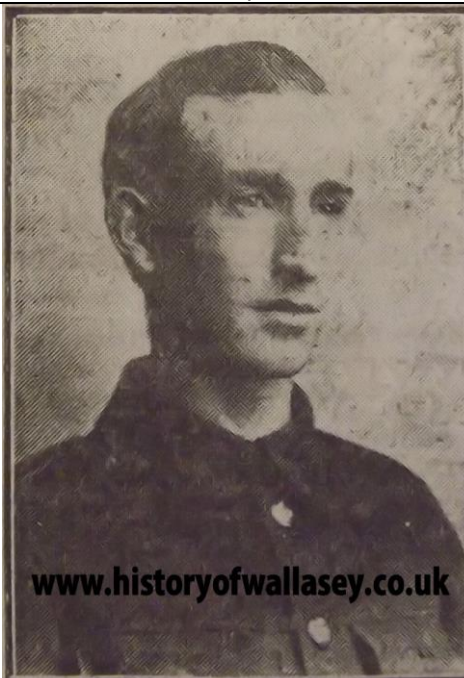

News Report

Fatal Gas Poisoning

The sad news has been received by Mrs. Amelia Hughes, of 17, Lathom Avenue, Liscard, that her youngest son, Bombr. Oliver Harry Hughes died for gas poisoning on October 15th, while being transferred from a casualty clearing station to a base hospital. He joined the army at the commencement of the war, and had over two in France, where he was twice wounded and gassed. He was buried with full military honours in the cemetery at Rouen. Thirty-one years of age, he was educated at St. Mary's School, Liscard, and was formerly employed as joiner with Mr. T. Samuel, contractor, 14, Rudgrave Square, Egremont.
