Ship's Butcher Dies Of Wounds

The sad intelligence has been received that Driver John (Jack) Hynes, Royal Horse Artillery, died of wounds on August 29 at the Casualty Clearing Station, France. He enlisted in September, 1917, and had been ten months in France. He was educated at St. Joseph's School, Wheatland Lane, Seacombe, and was formerly a ship's butcher in the employ of the White Star Line. His wife, Mrs Dora Hynes, resides at 47. Palermo Street, Seacombe.

The Rev. Thomas H. Scott, C.F., writes expressing sympathy with Mrs Hynes. Her husband was cheerful to the end, and received the last sacrament of his church.
