Egremont Soldier Killed [July 1917]

Pte. Marcus Pritchard Irwin, of the Royal Sussex Regt., who was reported in the 'Wallasey News,' on October 7, 1916, as "missing," has now been officially reported as killed in action. He was educated at St. Mary's School, and was in business with his father. He attended the Memorial Church, Liscard, and was fond of sports generally. He was the youngest son of Mr. and Mrs. H. Irwin, 67, Green Lane, Egremont.

His elder brother, Pte. Harry Irwin, who had his left arm broken, which had to be amputated, has been discharged from the Army and is going to Canada.
