#### News Report

##### Old Grammar School Boy Killed

The sad news has been received by Mr. Harry Jennings, of Fern Lea, Lyndhurst Road, Wallasey, of the death of his eldest son, Rifleman H.S. Jennings (Stan) who was killed almost instantly by a shell on July 31<sup>st</sup>, whilst consolidating a position which had been taken from the enemy. The deceased was an old boy of the Wallasey Grammar School, and was a member of the Magazine Sailing Club and the New Brighton Football Club. He was a popular young man, and as his Company Officer writes:- "His death is a great loss, and he will be very much missed by his numerous friends."

Rifleman Jennings came home from Canada to join the Army, and was transferred from the Lancashire Hussars to the King's Liverpool Regt.
