

<p>News Report</p> <p><u>Lost at Sea</u></p> <p>Much sympathy has been expressed for Mrs. Johnson, "Clodagh," Falkland Road, whose husband, Chief Engineer William Henry Johnson, was lost at sea on December 18, 1917. He was 51 years of age, and had been in the service of the Clyde Steamship Co. (formerly the Waterford S.S. Co.) since 1900, and was previously with the Sligo S.S. Co. The widow is left with four sons and two daughters, and another son was killed in action on June 16, 1915.</p> <p>Captain Charles Minard, also if the same address was lost in a sister ship, and was a popular Waterford shipmaster.</p>
