News Report

Wallasey Runner Killed

The sad news has been received that Pte. William Duncan Johnston, of the King's Liverpool Regt., who was a runner, was hit by a sniper, and killed instantaneously. He was educated at the Commercial Travellers' School Pinner, and employed as a clerk with Messrs H.B. Russell and Co., Ltd., African Merchants, Dale Street, Liverpool. He attended St. Hilary's Church, Wallasey, and was the second son of the late R.J. and H. Johnston, Liverpool. The gallant soldier resided with his sisters at 20, Leasowe Road, Wallasey.

Two other brothers are serving with the colours, one in the Army and another in the Transport service.
