#### News Report

##### Liscard Lieutenant Killed

Much local sympathy will assuredly be extended to Mr and Mrs G.H. Jones, 48, Strathcona Road, Liscard, in the irreparable loss which they have sustained in the death at the front of their only son, Second-Lieutenant Alec Jones, of the King's Liverpool Regiment.

A telegram to the parents has conveyed the sad intelligence that he has been killed in action in France. The gallant young officer attained his nineteenth birthday on April 19<sup>th</sup> last, and he was not only the only son but the only child of his bereaved parents. Educated at the Wallasey Grammar School, he passed with honours in every department for the Oxford examination, and a military career also full of rich promise has been tragically cut short. The late second-lieutenant was trained at the Officers' Training Corps, Inns Court, London.
