#### News Report

#### Killed Instantly

Mr. G.H. Jones, of 48, Strathcona Road, Liscard, has received information from the Commanding Officer that his son, Lieutenant Eric Jones, whose death we reported last week, was struck in the chest with a piece of shell which killed him instantly. The trenches were being bombarded and a dug-out had been blown in by a shell. Lieutenant Jones took a rescue party to dig the men out when he was killed. Mr Jones has since received a message from Buckingham Palace expressing their Majesties' sympathy in his sad loss.
