Seacombe Lance-Corporal Killed

Lance-Corpl. Frank Edgar Joes, of the King's Liverpool Rifles, was killed in action on July 31. He enlisted at the outbreak of the war, and had been in France over two years. He was employed by the Liverpool Cotton Association, and was a keen footballer. He was the second son of Mr. and Mrs. R.J. Jones, 79, Kelvin Road, Seacombe.
