<p>News Report</p> <p><u>Seacombe Soldier Killed</u></p> <p>Private James Jones, of the Cheshire Regt., was previously reported in the "News" as killed in action near Gaza. Lieut. T.L. Martin, writing to his mother, 60, Demesne Street, Seacombe, says:- "He was wounded by a shrapnel shell, which burst over us on March 27<sup>th</sup>, He was one of the best fellows in the company, always cheerful, and the sort of man we could rely on, and I feel his loss most acutely. Please accept my heartiest sympathy with you in your much greater affliction."</p>
