News Report

Leaves Wife and Seven Children

An official intimation has been received to the effect that Lance-Corpl. Samuel Jones, of the Manchester Regt., died of wounds on October 5th. Lance-Corpl. Jones, who was 36 years of age, formerly resided with his wife and seven children at 6, Cecil Road, Liscard. He joined the Manchester Regt., and in July, 1915, went to the Dardanelles where he was wounded in the leg. In April of last year he embarked for France and was invalided home with trench fever. He finally journeyed to France in June of this year and received wounds in the chest and right doot on October 3rd, succumbing two days later.
