News Report

Corporation Employee Killed

The sad intelligence has been received of the death of Pte. Stanley Jones, of the Cheshire, Regiment, who was killed in action on August 1. He joined the Army in September, 1914, went to France in September, 1915, and was drafted in Salonika, where he was laid up in hospital with dysentery, and after his recovery was sent back to France. He was educated at St. Paul's School, Seacombe, and employed in the Corporation gas department. He attended St. John's Mission, and was a member of the Young Men's Club. He was the eldest son of Mr. and Mrs. Edward Jones, 37, King Street, Egremont.

Capt. J.E. Pilkington writes :-

"It is with the deepest regret that I have to inform you of the death in action of your son, Pte. Stanley Jones. He was a good soldier, and will be sadly missed by his comrades. On behalf of his company and myself may I offer to you our deepest sympathy."
