News Report

Village Soldier Killed

Mrs. Jones, of 6, Wallasey Terrace, Wallasey Village, has received news that her husband, Private William Henry Jones, of the 6th Battalion (Queen's) Royal West Surrey Regiment, has been killed while serving at the front in France. Pathetically enough the War Office announcement was received on the ninth birthday of her little girl.

Private Jones joined in February last, and proceeded to the front in December.

Before joining the army he was engaged in the building trade. He was formerly well-known as a member of the Wallasey Village Silver Band. Thirty-nine years of age, he leaves a widow and seven young children.

Private Jones joined the Royal West Surrey Regiment with a friend, Private George Taker, a former Wallasey tramway employee, who was killed at the front some time ago.
