Kehoe, of 49 Byerley Street, Seacombe, died of pneumonia at the Albert Hall Military Hospital, Nottingham, on the 31<sup>st</sup> October. Although 57 years of age, he joined the Army Pay Corps about three ago, and succumbed after about ten days' illness. He was for many years in the employ of Messrs Thomas Rigby &amp; Son, Ltd., of Waterloo Dock, Liverpool, and had contributed articles frequently to Waterlord newspapers, of which told he was a native. His son, Lance-Corpl. J.M. Kehoe, of the Liverpool Rifles, won the Military Medal some months ago.</p>
