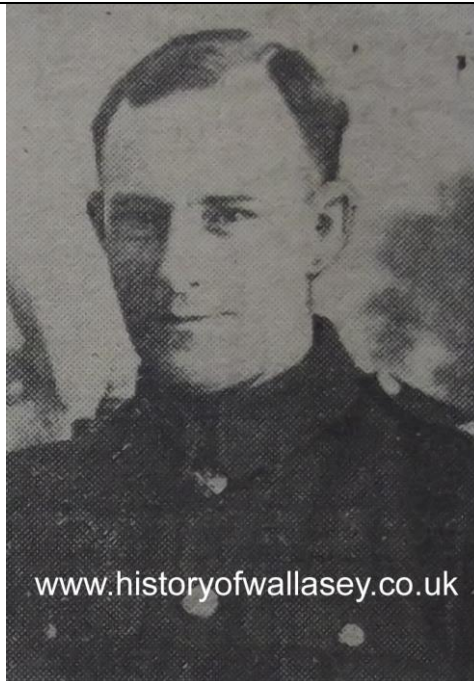

"Carried On" When Wounded

Mr A.M. Kelly, of 16 Ivor Road, Egremont, has received official information that her husband, Pte. Archibald M. Kelly (aged 39) of the Machine Gun Corps, was killed in action on the 24th September Second-Lieut. McLean writes:- "We attacked on the morning of the 24th inst., and while going over the top your husband was slightly wounded in the back. The fellows with him bandaged him up, and begged of him to go to the dressing station. He refused to do so, and asked to carry on, when he was shot through the heart, and died instantly. He was always cheery, always ready to do his utmost, and always so keen, and a thorough good soldier." Prior to enlisting he was employed by Messrs. Paton, McLaren & Co., Tithebarn Street, Liverpool.
