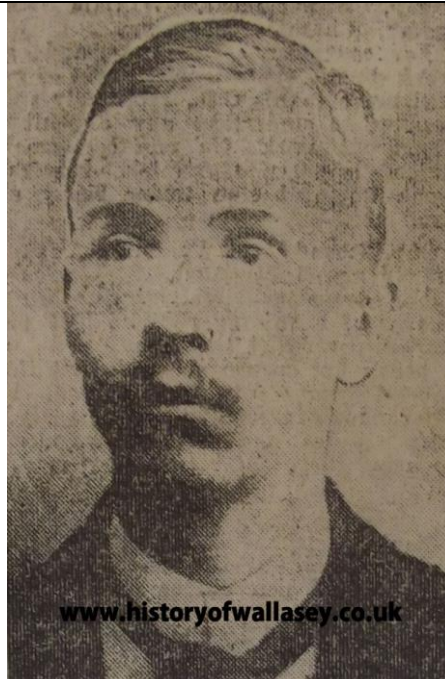

Two Brothers

One Killed : Another Missing

Private [Thomas Kelly](#) (Cheshires), aged 32, has died in general hospital, France, from wounds received in action on 8th October. He was educated at S.S. Peter and Paul's Schools, New Brighton, and was a plasterer by trade. He joined the Army last March, and was the youngest son of the late Patrick Kelly, of New Brighton, and brother-in-law of Mrs Edith Kelly, 4, Woodhall Avenue, Egremont.

A second son, Private **Joseph Kelly** (Cheshires), aged 42, has been officially reported as "missing" since May last year. He was an electrician and went through the Boer War. Another brother is serving with the Colours.
