<p>News Report</p> <p><u>Two Brothers</u></p> <p><u>One Killed : Another Missing</u></p> <p>Private Thomas Kelly (Cheshires), aged 32, has died in general hospital, France, from wounds received in action on 8th October. He was educated at S.S. Peter and Paul's Schools, New Brighton, and was a plasterer by trade. He joined the Army last March, and was the youngest son of the late Patrick Kelly, of New Brighton, and brother-in-law of Mrs Edith Kelly, 4, Woodhall Avenue, Egremont.</p> <p>A second son, Private Joseph Kelly (Cheshires), aged 42, has been officially reported as "missing" since May last year. He was an electrician and went through the Boer War. Another brother is serving with the Colours.</p>
