News Report

Adjutant's Only Son

Official news has been received that Signaller Robert Henry Kiddle, King's Liverpool Regt., died of wounds on March 15. He was born at Liverpool on February 5, 1898, and educated at St. Olave's Grammar School, London, and became Editor of the School Magazine, "The Olavian." He was also a corporal in the school Cadet Corps. He joined the Liverpool Scottish and was trained at Oswestry, where he qualified as signaller, and proceeded to France in January last, and was appointed Signaller to his old company.

The Sister in charge of the Casualty Clearing Station wrote to his parents on Friday of last week that he came into the hospital seriously wounded in the head, thigh, arm, and abdomen, and his condition was hopeless from the first.

He was the only son of Mr and Mrs J.H. Kiddle, 73, Urmson Road, Liscard. Mr. J.H. Kiddle was well-known as assistant adjutant and afterwards adjutant of the Wallasey Battalion, Cheshire Volunteer Regt.
