Corporal A.H. Kilby Killed

Official news has been received that Corporal Hugh Kilby, of the Northumberland Fusiliers, has been killed in action. The gallant corporal, who was 35 years of age, and unmarried, joined the forces in March, last year, and went to the front in December. The Chaplain, who was with him at the end, has sent a very sympathetic letter to his mother.
