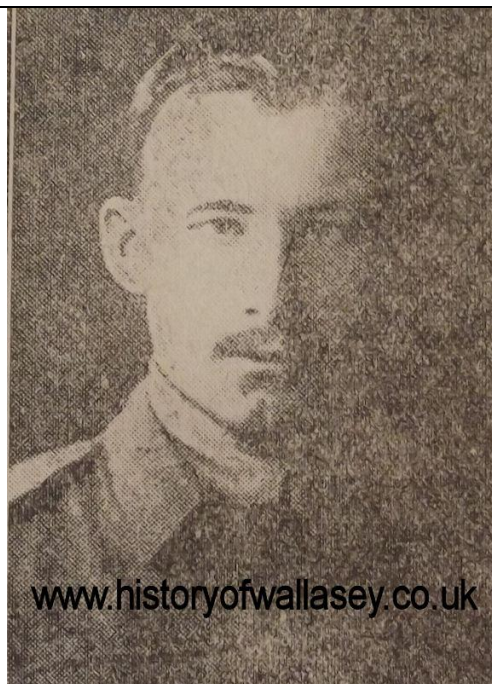

Poulton Lance-Corporal Killed

The sad intelligence has been received from the War Office that Lance-Corporal Clifford Lawton, of the Australian Regt., was killed in action on May 2. He joined the colours some two years ago, and served in Egypt and was afterwards drafted to France. He had been seven years in Australia, and the news of his death is all the sadder from the fact that he was killed within a week after he went back to France. He was 26 years of age and an electrician, and the second son of Mr. and Mrs. G.A. Lawton, 37, Brougham Road, Poulton.
