#### Killed At Ypres

Much sympathy will be felt in Wallasey for Mrs. A. Lawton, of 19 Clwyd Street, New Brighton in the death of her son, Lance-Corporal G. Lawton, of the 6<sup>th</sup> Battalion King's Liverpool Regiment, who was killed in action near Ypres on May 6th, Lance-Corporal Lawton, who was 23 years of age, went to the front last February after having been with the Territorials for four years. He was the son of the late Sergeant-Major J.H. Lawton, R.A.M.C., and was well known in the district. The deceased soldier has a brother in the same regiment who is expecting to go to the front shortly.
