News Report

Second Brother Killed

Rifleman T.C. Leaver, of the London Regiment, the second son of Mr and Mrs C.O. Leaver, of 38, Park Road, Lytham, and only surviving brother of Mr. J.H. Leaver, 8, Wellesley Road, Liscard, has been killed in action in France. Rifleman Leaver, who was 28 years of age, lived for twenty years or so in Liscard, but at the outbreak of war was in business in London. He enlisted in 1914, and was drafted out to France in June, 1915. His younger brother, Rifleman H.R. Leaver, of the K.L.R., was killed in action at Ypres in April, 1915.
