<u>One Of The "Pals"</u>	
<p>By a letter from the company commander, Mr. and Mrs. R.J. Ledson, of 14, St. Winifred Road, Wallasey, have been informed of the death in action on September 1st of their son, Rifleman Chris Ledson, K.L.R. He was twenty years of age, and enlisted in the "Pals" about two years ago. He was drafted to France last April, and was shortly afterwards wounded in the head by shrapnel. Formerly residing in Liverpool, he was educated at Longmoor Lane Council Schools and Oakes Institute, and before enlisting was in the employ of the British Law Insurance Company, Dale Street, Liverpool.</p>
