Seacombe Rifleman Killed

Rifleman Thomas Percival Lever, K.L.R., has been killed in action, and was previously wounded. He enlisted in Sept., 1915, and had been two years in France. He was 25 years of age, was educated at Riverside Council School, and attended Seacombe Congregational Church. He was the youngest son of Mr and Mrs J. Lever, late of 80, Buchanan Road, Seacombe. They had resided in Wallasey for over 40 years.
