#### News Report

##### Corporation Employee Killed

Official imitation has been received at 46. Fairview Avenue, Liscard, that Pte. George H. Lewis, of the Cheshire Regt., has been killed in action.

Pte. Lewis, who was 25 years of age, was formerly employed by the Wallasey Corporation at the Cemetery. He has two other brothers serving, Pte. Thomas Lewis, of the Machine Gun Corps, and Pte. J. Lewis, of the R.A.M.C.

The Chaplain, the Rev. J.D. Happle, writing to his parents, says:- "I regret to inform you that your son was killed in action on February 1<sup>st</sup>. I buried him in a British cemetery the next day, just behind the line. May I offer you my sincere sympathy in your sad loss, and may God comfort you with the power of His Holy Spirit and in the knowledge that Greater love haith no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends."
