#### News Report

##### Killed In No Man's Land

Official telegrams have been received from the War Office that Second-Lieutenant Cyril J.G. Livesey, who was reported as "missing," is now reported killed in action on January 4. He joined the Army Service Corps on August 11, 1914, and immediately went to Aldershot in training for his commission. He was drafted in France in May, 1915, with the Middlesex Regt. Educated at Liscard High School, he was previously in the Bank of Liverpool (Wallasey branch). Twenty-three years of age last July, he was the eldest child of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Livesey, "Hillsboro," Manor Road, Liscard.

His chum writes:- "I hardly know how to tell you, byt the truth is that poor Cyril was killed in action on the night of January 3. It appears that he went out to visit an advanced post, and whilst in 'No Man's Land.' He was shot through the head by enemy machine gun. It is certain he suffered no pain whatever."
