Died From Wounds

Private George B. Lowe, K.S.L.I. (late Cheshires). Aged 23, who was shot in both legs, succumbed to his wounds on November 20th, at the General Dames Camier's Hospital, France. He was educated at St. Paul's School, Seacombe, and was a violinist by profession, being well-known and highly respected in Wallasey. He was the eldest son of Mr. Charles B. Lowe, and the late Emily Lowe, of 27, Hartismere Road, Seacombe. Another son is serving with the colours.
