Two Brothers

One Killed, The Other Wounded

We regret to announce that John K. MacPherson, of the 6th Battalion, Border Regiment, whose home is at 'Kerrow', 97, Manor Road, Liscard, has been killed in action. A fine young fellow, John MacPherson joined the Border Regiment at the outbreak of the war, and went to the Dardanelles in July. H took part in the landing at Sulva Bay, and had practically been continually in action till the time of his death.

His older brother, Alick MacPherson, who two years ago was a piper in the Liverpool Scottish, on the outbreak of the war joined the New Zealand Expeditionary Force. He took part in the defence of the Suez Canal and accompanied the Australians
