Liscard Corporal Killed

Official intimation has been received from the War Office notifying the death in action of Corporal Harold A. Mackie, of the King's Liverpool Regiment, which took place on the 17th February. He was the third son of Mr. and Mrs. E.F. Mackie, of 13, Edinburgh Road, Liscard, and would have reached his twentieth birthday last Monday. He enlisted on August 8th, 1914, and went to France in March, 1915, and was wounded in May of the same year. He returned to France in January, 1916, and had not since been home. Previous to enlistment he worked as a monumental sculptor with his father. He was educated at Manor Road School, and was a splendid swimmer; having won many prizes and medals. He was a member of the Seacombe and Egremont Swimming Club. He was beloved by all who knew him, and his loss will be generally deplored. Another brother is also serving with the same regiment.
