News Report

Wallasey Footballer Killed

The sad intelligence has been received that Private Frederick *Fred) Major, King's Shropshire Light Infantry, was killed in action on November 30. He enlisted in December, 1914, and was drafted to France, September, 1915. He was educated at Magazine Lane Schools, and acted as assistant barber on the ill-fated "Lusitania." He was a member of Rake Lane Brotherhood, and played football for the Liscard Rovers. He was 24 years of age, and the eldest son of Mrs. Ellen Major, and of the late Mr. S. Dennis Major, 18 Valkyrie Road, Liscard. He resided with his brother at 13, Wentworth Avenue, New Brighton.
