News Report

Old Wallasey Pal Killed

News has been received by Mr. and Mrs. George Marley, "Drumla," Dalmorton Road, New Brighton, of the death on active service of their second son, George Michael. He was 22 years of age, and was an old boy of St. Francis Xavier's College, Liverpool. On their formation he joined the Wallasey Pals (13th Cheshires) and went to France with them in September, 1915, where he was wounded at the battle of the Somme, July, 1916. After a period of ten months, chiefly spent in hospital, he was again drafted to the Front.
