<p>The death is announced of Gunner John William Marshall, who was killed in action on Friday last in France. The deceased soldier, who was a son of ex-Sergt. John Marshall, of the Cheshire County Police, also served in the Cheshire County Police for two years, and joined the Wallasey Borough Police on the formation of that force in April, 1913. He enlisted in the County Palatine R.G.A. on May 6, 1915.</p>
