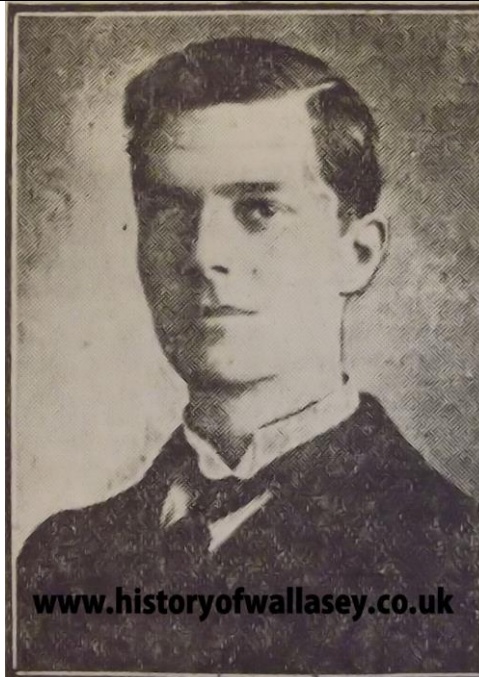

News Report

Died Of Pneumonia

Pte. Eric Stafford Basnett Martin, Canadian Regiment, died of pneumonia on October 1st at the Victoria Hospital, Montreal. He joined the Navy when war broke out, and after being several times ill he went to Canada and enlisted there. He was 23 years pf age, and leaves a widow and baby, who reside at 4 Deveraux Drive, Somerville, His elder brother, Captain Cyril Martin, was killed in action six months ago.
