#### Poulton Footballer Killed

Mrs McKee, 16, Cherry Bank Road, Seacombe, has received official intimation that her husband, Driver John McKee, Royal Field Artillery, was killed in action on April 24. He enlisted in February, 1915, and had been 2½ years in France. He was 25 years of age, and formerly employed at the Corporation destructor, Gorse Lane. He played football for Poulton Rovers. His widow is left with six young children, and his parents reside at 3, Clayton Lane, Poulton.
