News Report

Egremont Soldier Dies From Wounds

Pte. T. McMillin, the eldest son of Mr A. McMillin, late of 60, Clarendon Road, Egremont, and now at 79, Tithebarn Street, Liverpool, has died in a hospital in France from wounds received in action. The gallant young soldier, who was 25 years of age, went to France with the Liverpool "Pals," and was wounded on July 1st at the battle of the Somme. He was invalided home, and recovered at the Military Hospital in Whalley. Subsequently he was attached to another battalion of the King's Liverpool Regt., and was wounded in the battle of Arras. He was removed to No. 7 Canadian General Hospital in France where he died.
