Gunner Dies of Wounds

Official intimation has been received that Gunner William Alfred McShea, Royal Field Artillery, died of wounds on March 23. He enlisted in January, 1915, and had been in France about two and a half years. He was educated at St. Joseph's Schools, Wheatland Lane, and was formerly in the employ of Mr. J. Kenna, Brighton Street, Seacombe. He was the only son of Nurse McShea and of the late Mr. Robert McShea, 19 Geneva Road, Seacombe.
