<p>Chronicles News</p> <p><u>"A Good Soldier"</u></p> <p>An official intimation has been received by Mrs. McTiernan, of 11 Alfred Road, Seacombe, that her husband, Private Michael McTiernan, died of wounds in France on May 5th. He joined the Royal Welsh Fusiliers in 1916, and had seen two years' active service, during which period he participated in much heavy fighting. His officer writes of him as "a good soldier, of a lively and cheerful disposition." Private McTiernan was employed at the Corporation Road Fat Works, Birkenhead. HE leaves a widow and five children.</p>
