Former Council Employee Killed

Pte. George Frederick Meachem was killed in action on the 31st of August. He came home from India in November, 1914, and joined up with the King's Royal Rifle Corps, and was drafted to France, where he was transferred to the Cheshire Regt. HE had been four times wounded and gassed, and also suffered from trench fever. He was educated at the Old Rock School, Magazine Lane, New Brighton, and was at one time was employed in the sewage department of the Wallasey Corporation. He was the third son of Mrs. E. Meachem, and of the late Mr. H. Meachem, 7 Alfred Road, Seacombe.
