##### Seacombe Private Killed

Private Joseph Measham, of the Cheshire Regiment was killed in action on September 3<sup>rd</sup>. He lodged at 56, Lucerne Road, Seacombe, and previously lived in Withen's Lane. He was employed for seven years at Dick's Boot Stores, 171, Poulton Road, and had only been at the front a few weeks. His father was a Sergeant-Major in the Grenadier Guards.
